Retired to Stud in 2008, sire of the winners of 1308 races; including **BATTAASH (IRE)** (Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, **Gr.1**), **HARRY ANGEL (IRE)** (Darley July Cup Stakes, **Gr.1**), **MECCA'S ANGEL (IRE)** (Nunthorpe Stakes, **Gr.1**, Coolmore Nunthorpe Stakes, **Gr.1**), **LETHAL FORCE (IRE)** (Darley July Cup, **Gr.1**).

MAKING EYES (IRE), won 5 races at 3 to 5 years at home and in France and £89,483 including Belfred/Brit. Studs EBF Hoppings Stakes, Newcastle, **L.** and Prix Jacques de Bremond, Vichy, **L.**, placed twice including third in Foundation Stakes, Goodwood, **L.**; dam of 2 foals of racing age including- Black Envy (GB) (2016 f. by Kingman (GB)), realised 400,000gns Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, Book 1, 2017, unraced to date. (2015 c. by Invincible Spirit (IRE)), died at 2 years.

EN DIRECTA (CHI), winner in Chile; dam of **EN GUERRA (CHI)**, won Gran Premio Gonzalo Boffill de Caso, Valparaiso, **Gr.2**.

Sand Pebbles (IRE), ran once at 3 years; dam of winners.

Fusaichi's Angel (USA), unraced; dam of **HAKASSAN (CHI)**, won Premio dos Mil Guineas (2000 Guineas), Hipodromo Chile, **Gr.1**, Premio St Leger, Hipodromo Chile, **Gr.1** and P.Gran Criterium-Mauricio Serrano Palma, Hipodromo Chile, **Gr.1**.

Ellen's Dancer (USA), unraced; dam of winners.

REZA (USA), winner in Brazil; grandam of **RELENTO (BRZ)**, Champion older horse in Uruguay in 2008 & 2010, won Clasico Las Piedras, Hipo Maronas, **L.** (twice), G. P. Jose Pedro Ramirez - Copa El Pais, Hipo Maronas, **L.**, Gran Premio Presidente de la Republica, Hipo Maronas, **L.**, Clasico Carlos Pellegrini, Hipo Maronas, **L.** (twice).

Topa (USA), ran in U.S.A. at 3 and 4 years; dam of **CHAMPION STAR (BRZ)**, won Grande Premio Ministro da Agricultura, Cidade Jardim, **Gr.2**.
