NEW APPROACH (IRE), Chesnut horse, 2005, by Galileo (IRE). Champion 2yr old in Europe in 2007. Champion 3yr old in Europe in 2008. Won 8 races, value £1,992,070, at 2 and 3 years, (7-8½) including National Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.1**, Dewhurst Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.1**. Retired to Stud in 2009, and sire of the winners of 686 races; including **MASAR (IRE)** (Investec Derby Stakes, **Gr.1**), **DAWN APPROACH (IRE)** (Dubai Dewhurst Stakes, **Gr.1**, National Stakes, **Gr.1**, St James's Palace Stakes, **Gr.1**), **SULTANINA (GB)** (Nassau Stakes, **Gr.1**).

AL BAIDAA (GB), won 1 race at 3 years and £13,300 and placed 5 times, from only 7 starts; dam of 1 living foal of racing age including-

Enchanting Man (GB) (2016 c. by Dawn Approach (IRE)), unraced to date.
